CDBG National Objectives were discussed.

- Projects must benefit at least 70% low- and moderate-income persons; or
- Project must aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight; or
- Meet other community development needs having a particular urgency because of existing conditions that pose a serious threat to the health and welfare of the community where other financial resources are not available to meet such needs. The application must certify, and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs must concur that such conditions exist.

Discussion of the City of Guyton's proposed CDBG project continued as to Activities/Location, etc.

Conflict of Interest was discussed. If a City Council member resides in the selected target area, the City will follow Conflict of Interest procedures.

Also discussed Fair Housing/Equal Opportunity.
